Download Binary Snapshots

Available binary snapshots are attached as *.zip archives to their respective [project pages](#). Just click the on the download link and tell your browser where to store them on disk, which you need to remember for your subsequent [site.properties configuration](#). We usually use something like `~/projects/jpf/` as a common root.

Note:

most JPF projects are still fast moving, so we recommend using the source repositories to stay up-to-date.

At least for the jpf-core, we have pretty strict repository policies (no push that doesn't pass the regression tests), i.e. you don't have to worry about catching a temporarily broken developer version
